# Pool Rules

1. ALL swimmers must show pool tags to the lifeguard on duty on each visit to the pool, and whenever asked.
2. **Appropriate bathing suits** MUST be worn. No cutoffs, undergarments with shorts, etc.
3. There is no changing facility at the pool.
4. Anyone under 10 years old MUST be accompanied by an adult or person at least 16 years of age.
5. Use of alcohol and/or drugs is STRICTLY PROHIBITED in and around the pool area.
6. Persons who appear intoxicated or under the influence of alcohol or drugs are NOT PERMITTED in or around the pool area.
7. Profanity, vulgar remarks and improper behavior are PROHIBITED.
8. **NO** running.
9. **NO** pushing / throwing anyone into the pool.
10. **NO** horseplay involving head or neck holding.
11. **NO** sitting on other swimmer's shoulders.
12. **NO** diving in the the shallow end (east of the rope).
13. ALL entry into the pool must be straight out from the edge, away from steps, ladders and other swimmers. No back- or twisting-entry into the pool.
14. Spitting water and/or blowing the nose in the water is PROHIBITED.
15. Persons with open sores or rashes will NOT be PERMITTED in the water.
16. Any child wearing a flotation device MUST be within arm's reach of a responsible adult.
17. **NO** gum or candy is permitted in the pool.
18. **NO** food is permitted in or directly around the pool.
19. Smoking at the edge of the pool, including the baby pool is NOT PERMITTED.
20. **NO** balls, except beach balls and similar, are permitted in or around the pool area. (eg: footballs, rubber balls, tennis balls, baseballs, volleyballs, etc).
21. **NO** hanging on the rope.
22. **NO** jumping from nor sitting / hanging on the ladders.
23. **No glass of any kind** is permitted in or around the pool. (Bottles, containers, etc)
24. **NO** animals (except qualified assist animals) are permitted in the pool area.
25. **NO** bicycles are permitted in the pool area.

26. Pool toys ONLY will be permitted in the pool; no hard plastic toys. If in doubt, check with the lifeguard on duty.
27. Hair longer than shoulder-length MUST be tied-back or braided at all times while in the pool.
28. All trash MUST be placed in the trashcans provided.
29. 'Butt Buckets' are to be used for cigarettes / cigars only. NO DIAPERS.
30. **Bathrooms MAY NOT be used for changing purposes.**
31. **NO** persons are permitted on the guard stand nor within the guard's area marked by the white lines, with the exception of the lifeguard(s) on duty.
32. During adult swims, all swimmers under the age of 18 years MUST be behind the white line on the pool deck. **No feet dangling in the water.** Babies under the age of 1 year are permitted in the pool with the parent during adult swim provided they are being held by the parent at all times.
33. Swimmers MUST obtain permission of the lifeguard on duty before using inner tubes, rafts and the like in the pool.
34. **NO** persons are permitted in the Pump Room or Community Center.
35. The pool phone may only be used, by lifeguards, in EMERGENCY situations.
36. If T-shirts must be worn for sunburn protection, they **MUST be white and waist-length.**
37. Persons found in the pool at any time other than when the pool is officially open will be SUBJECT TO ARREST and prosecution and pool privileges will be revoked for the remainder of the pool season.
38. Homeowners may ONLY use tags properly issued to them.
39. A Guest Pass is good for 5 FREE visits to the pool by your guests. Thereafter, guests may visit for \$5 per day, no charge for babies under 1 year of age.
40. Pool passes MAY ONLY be used for non-residents.
41. The pool area is not a hangout – PLEASE SWIM OR LEAVE.
42. The refrigerator is made available for swimmers' convenience. The Quakers Green Community Association is NOT RESPONSIBLE for items in the refrigerator. Please label your belongings.

## **BABY POOL**

1. **NO** persons over the age of 4 years are permitted in the baby pool.
2. PLEASE use disposable diapers covered by plastic pants.
3. **Parents are RESPONSIBLE for monitoring** their own children in the baby pool.
